He coordinates and leads teams of different specialists for surgeries that require especially challenging orthopedic demolitions and reconstructions (thoracic, abdominal, plastic and vascular surgeons).

He personally performed more than 3500 major ortho-trauma surgeries, of which more than 160 single or multilevel en bloc vertebrectomies/spondylectomies, involving surgery and microsurgery of surrounding organs due to aggressive neoplastic pathologies of the spine; over 1500 major spinal surgeries for scoliosis, spondylolisthesis, traumas, instabilities, infections, stenosis and spinal discopathies; over than 1000 major joints arthroplasty (hip, knee, shoulder, elbow).
